

Location

Just 2 hours from London and 3½ hours from Edinburgh, Sheffield is at the heart of the UK rail and road network. Situated around 1 hour from 4 international airports, we have a direct rail service from Manchester Airport into the city centre and direct shuttle bus access from Doncaster-Sheffield Airport. Manchester Airport is the closest with the most worldwide connections. Over 200 destinations fly into Manchester from over 70 airlines. It is the 3rd busiest airport in Britain and the Global Gateway to the North.

Globe Travel Awards voted Manchester Airport the Best UK Airport 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018.

Eurostar travellers can take advantage of switching trains at London St Pancras for a direct service into Sheffield, making the journey from Paris to Sheffield around 5 hours.
