- Abstracts should be no more than 300 words and must be structured as follows: Title, Authors and Affiliations, Introduction, Aim of Study, Materials & Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- Abstracts should be submitted by 18 February 2021.
- Confirmation of acceptance by 28 February 2021.
